Year-to-Date, URC has Average car count of 31 . . . . .  
URC HEADS TO NEW EGYPT SATURDAY NIGHT, SEPTEMBER 1

It could very well be URC's most competitive season; with sixteen different feature winners so far this season after twenty-two completed race dates. As many tracks struggle across the county with car count for the 360 sprints, this is not a problem for URC.

With twenty-one point races now complete, URC has delivered an average car count of 31. URC's highest car count came at the Williams Grove Speedway for the BAR'S LEAKS/Rislone Sprint Nationals when fifty-three cars took part in qualifying. The lowest car count of the season was twenty-five at the Orange County Fair Speedway. Overall, URC has delivered full fields of cars to their promoters and the fans who attend the URC events. The success of this car count finds the bulk of the credit going to URC's handicapping system. Not only is it attractive to drawing strong fields of cars, it also creates multiple feature winners and brings new faces to URC's victory lane. Eight drivers have scored their first career win under the United Racing Company banner this season and most recently, Burlington, NJ driver Robbie Stillwaggon dominated the twenty-five lap feature event on Saturday night at the Delaware International Speedway.

URC, celebrating their sixtieth year in operation in 2007 and remains the nation's oldest traveling sprint car series has six race dates remaining on their 2007 schedule of events. The URC sprints will return to the New Egypt Speedway on Saturday night, September 1 for their fourth stop of the season. In the three previous events at New Egypt, Kevin Welsh was a feature winner as Michael Carber won on June 23 and July 14.

In the Fred's Trailer Parts NEW Series, a mini-point series within URC finds Trevor Lewis leading the point chase with 799 points, holding a slim point leader over runner-up Curt Michael who has 751 points. Sitting in third is Chris Coyle with 704 points as Ed Aikin follows in fourth with 686 point and Mark Bitner makes-up the top five with 607 points.
