Grandview Speedway to host as . . .

Thunder on the Hill Returns Wednesday May 21 with the Keystone Cup Opener for the PA Posse

The racing season has just begun to hit full stride in Central Pennsylvania. The young talent has already started to show signs of brilliance while the veteran drivers still display the finesse and ability that has kept them as the top local competition in the country. On May 21st, the stars of the Pennsylvania Posse will travel to Bechtelsville, PA where they will wage war on the high-banks of the always demanding, Grandview Speedway for the opening night of the Keystone Cup 410 Sprint Series.

The Keystone Cup event at Grandview also marks the opening night for the NAPA Auto Parts Thunder on the Hill Racing Series. Series Promoters Bruce Rogers and Bob Miller unite for their 19th season of hosting the series on the 1/3rd mile dirt oval. The \$5,000 to win show will feature time trials, qualifying events, and a 35-lap feature. Also on the card for the night are the ever-popular ARDC wingless midgets.

Leading the drivers to the Keystone Cup weekend will be defending Keystone Cup Champion Fred Rahmer of Salfordsville, PA. "Fast Freddie" is certainly no stranger to "The Hill" as the veteran has claimed 8 victories at the track in sprint car competition along with 4 Thunder on the Hill Championships. Rahmer also cut his racing teeth at Grandview in the modifieds where he won 45 races and 2 track championships. Todd Shaffer of Millerstown, PA should look to give Fred a run for the money. "Mr. Excitement" finally shook his eighteen year absence from victory lane at the speedway last July when the veteran won the PA Speedweek show at Grandview. Shaffer is no stranger to going "elbows up" and battling it out to win which is often the case when it comes to bullrings.

Other expected entrants for the show include Chad Layton, Greg Hodnett, Stevie Smith, Brian Leppo, Alan Cole, Mark Smith, Michael Carber, and Sean Michael to name a few.

Also on the card will be the ARDC wingless midgets. The "mighty midgets" have adopted a traditional non-wing midget and the racing has never been better. 2006 and 2007 point champion Andy Martin leads the drivers to the Grandview Speedway where Martin was able to capture a win during the 2006 season. Six-time champion Ray Bull is also no stranger to victory lane at Grandview. The Mega Motorsports driver will look to give Martin all he can handle on May 21st. Other drivers include Tracy Readinger, Steve Lenig, AJ Ernesto, P.J. Gargiulo, Bobby Goerner, and Frank Polimeda.

Part of the history of the Thunder on the Hill Series is providing fans opportunities that aren't otherwise available elsewhere. Last year's Inside/Out promotion was such a success that Bob Miller and Bruce Rogers have decided to bring the fans another opportunity to experience hot-laps at Grandview from inside the track. Fans that purchase advance tickets to the event will have the first opportunity to sign up for the promotion. Sign-up is absolutely free and will take place at the main gate and is being sponsored by COMDIAL Communications. COMDIAL is a long-time supporter of the Thunder on the Hill Racing Series and the fans that follow the series.

Advanced ticket sales for the Wednesday May 21st race are already under way. Adult tickets for the show are \$20, children 6-11 are \$5, and children under 6 are admitted free. The pit fee is \$25 and a pit license is not required.
