**SEVERE STORMS STOPS URC RUN AT DELAWARE INTERNATIONAL SATURDAY. . . .  
URC GEARS UP FOR TWO RACE WEEKEND INCLUDING \$4,000 TO WIN RISLONE SPRINT  
NATIONALS AT WILLIAMS GROVE FRIDAY NIGHT, JUNE 6**

There is no doubt that Delaware International Speedway Promoter Charlie Cathell was looking out for fans and competitors alike when he made a mid-afternoon call on Saturday to cancel the evenings racing program. The severe weather did arrive, with a series of violent lightning and thunder storms making their first strike around 5 PM and continued late into the night. No promoter likes to cancel a racing program but when weather odds are so great and fuel prices being what they are, you need to use the information at hand to make the right decision. For URC, this was their third rain out in the last four shows, and point leader Curt Michael is one driver that would like to see the rain go far away.

This coming weekend, the competitors of URC will be looking at their first two race weekend and it all kicks off at the Williams Grove Speedway on Friday night, June 6 with the 3rd Annual Rislone Sprint Nationals. On Saturday night, June 7, the URC Rislone Sprint Series will make their first stop of the season at the popular Lincoln Speedway.

The Friday night Rislone Sprint Nationals will be a time trial event with qualifying heat race events as well as a "C" and "B" main event to determine the starting field for the 25 lap \$4,000 to win Rislone Sprint Nationals. In the two previous Rislone Nationals, Pat Cannon was the winner in 2006 as Ed Aikin took top honors in 2008. A field of fifty sprint cars (open to all 360 and 358 sprints cars) is expected for this event at the Mechanicsburg, PA half-mile oval. Race time is set for 7 PM. B Main 1-4 Transfer 5-12-\$50, C Main 1-4 Transfer \$25, 5-13 \$50.

Then on Saturday night, June 7, the URC racers will head to the always exciting Lincoln Speedway for a regular show of heat race qualifying, a "B" Main and a twenty-five lap feature paying \$2,000 to the winner.

The URC season will continue with a visit to the Grandview Speedway on Saturday, June 14 followed by a two race weekend that opens on Friday night, June 20 at the Penn Can Speedway followed by a stop at the New Egypt Speedway on Saturday night, June 21. URC returns to the Delaware International Speedway on Saturday night, June 28.
