

TWENTY-SIX RACE TEAMS REPRESENTED AT URC SPRING MEETING SUNDAY

On Sunday afternoon, the United Racing Company held their annual Spring Competitors Meeting at the Clarion Hotel in New Castle, DE. A very impressive turnout found twenty-six race teams represented and in attendance. URC Managing Members John and Cher Zimmerman and Bob and Donna Miller presented in PowerPoint format, an inside look at the big season in store as the Rislone URC Sprint Series presents their sixty-second season.
