

RISLONE URC SPRINT SERIES TO TRY AGAIN -
OPENING DAY SET FOR DELAWARE INTERNATIONAL ON SATURDAY

Nothing sounds better than the roar of a 360 sprint car as fires enter the Delaware International Speedway through the fourth turn gate. On Saturday night, as many as thirty URC 360 sprint cars will invade the state of Delaware for the first point race of 2009 for the Rislone URC Sprint Series and the opening event of the Taylor & Messick Delaware State Sprint Series. Action will get underway at 7 PM at the Delaware International Speedway, located on Route 13 South in Delmar, DE.

A big season is planned for URC and the field of competitors is filled with talent. 410 sprint car driver Chad Layton will make the stop at Delaware International Speedway for the opening night as he attempts to chase the lucrative URC Championship. Joining Layton will be Michael Carber, Becca Anderson, Kramer Williamson, JJ Grasso and Davey Sammons, all favorites to take the win. That is, after they figure out a way to beat defending champion Curt Michael, who quite frankly, gets around the fast Delaware half-mile better than anyone.

A series of qualifying events and a "B" Main will lead up to the twenty-five lap \$2,000 to win URC feature event. The URC opener will mark the sixty-second season for URC.
